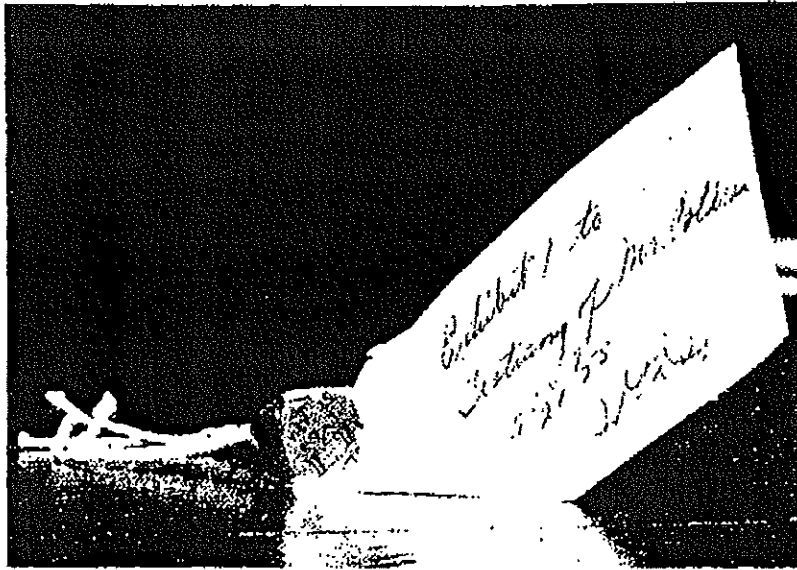
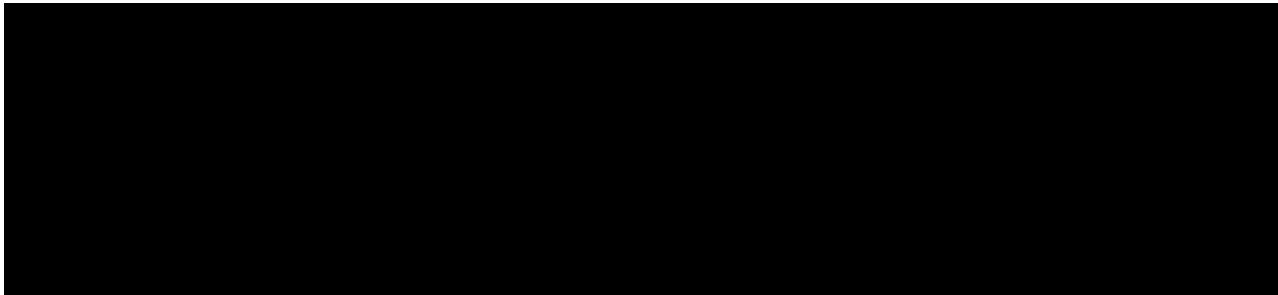

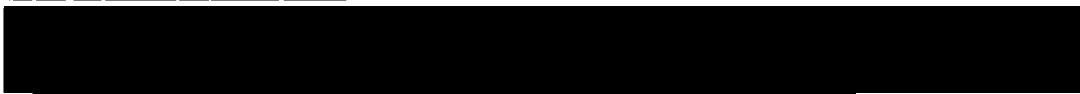


Ring Taken From the Body and Identified as Till's

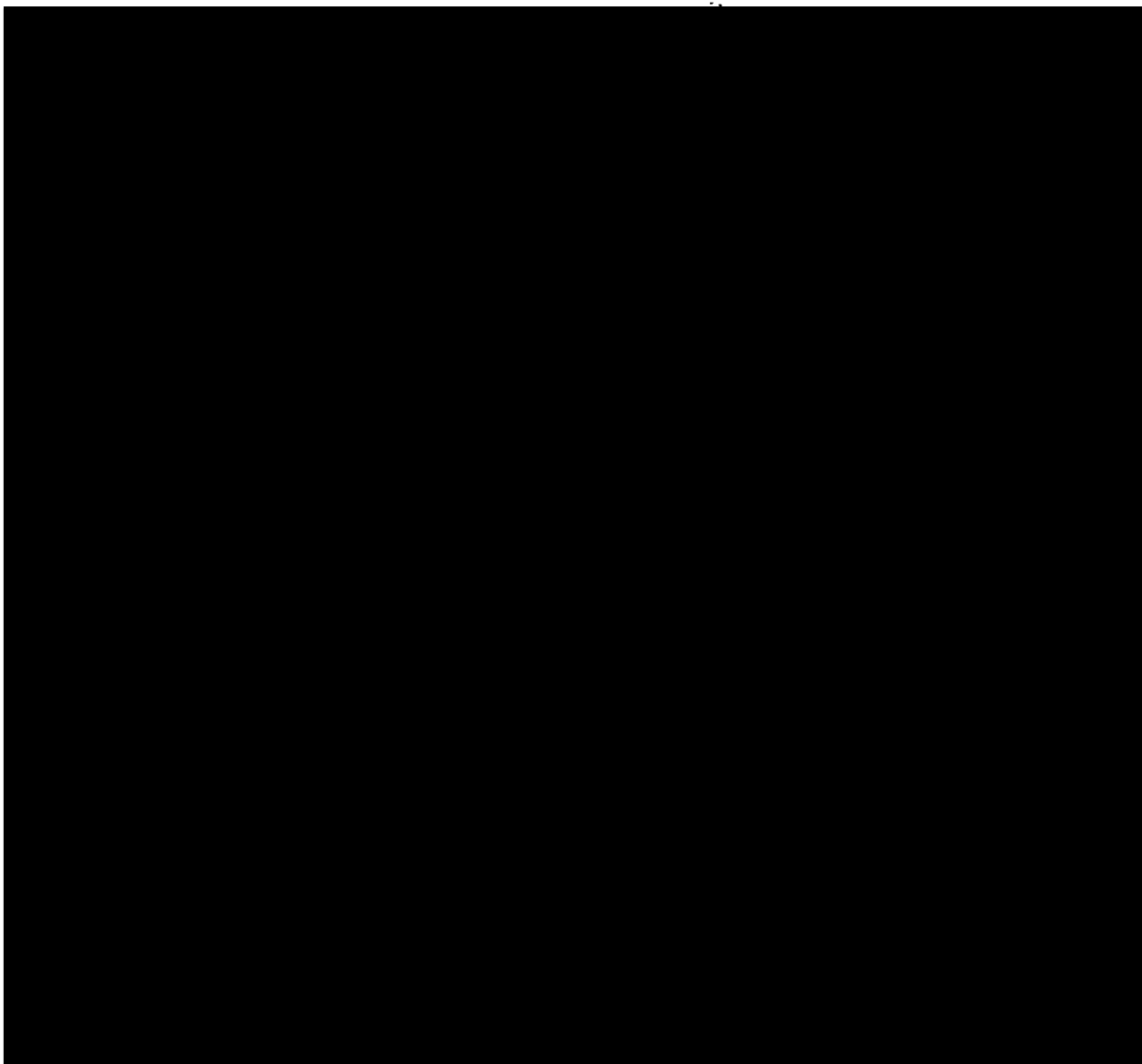
