An investigative judge with an international reputation, Jean-Louis Bruguière is the High Representative of the European Union to the United States for the fight against terrorism within the Terrorism Finance Tracking Program. Until 2007, he was responsible for the supervision and coordination of the anti-terrorism section in Paris. Having investigated more than 100 cases of terrorism during his 30 year career, from home-grown French and European terrorist organizations in the 1970s and 1980s, to the Algerian radical Islamists of the 1990s as well as the Al-Qaeda cells of today, Bruguière is considered on of the foremost experts in the West on terrorism issues.
