4. The Walker Family: In 1955 the Walker family lived in Glendora, Mississippi.

Robert Walker, Sr. worked for the Central Illinois Railroad and his wife, Henrietta Walker worked as a teacher in the local black public school. Living in the Walker home at the time of Till's abduction were Robert Walker Sr. and Henrietta Walker (both deceased),

and

The Walker home was situated in such a manner that one could see the Milam home and J.W. Milam's store from the residence.
